Charles Mead called the regular meeting of the Bridgewater Township Supervisors to order with the reading of the July 5, 2011 minutes. Charles Mead made a motion to approve the minutes with a few small changes. Kenneth Mead seconded the motion.

Supervisors Kenneth Mead and Charles Mead were present.

Charles Mead made a motion to approve the Treasurer's Report. Kenneth Mead seconded the motion.

Kenneth Mead made a motion for Ken Rauch to do the work on the Beebe Hollow Bridge for \$7000. Charles Mead seconded the motion. This bridge work was not bid because based on Ceco Engineering's inspection the quote for the work was \$1500. After Ken Rauch started the work they found that it was more involved, the concrete was rotten and there was a crack by the deck.

Charles Mead made a motion to check with East Rush Electric regarding doorbells for the main door and the office door. Kenneth Mead seconded the motion.

The Supervisors discussed the Rafferty Road culvert bid package from Bassett Engineering. They will contact Basset Engineering regarding parts of the package that are not pertinent to Bridgewater Township.

The Supervisors completed an application for a grant for guiderails on Rafferty Road at the Rafferty Road culvert. They received 2 quotes for the guiderails to help them submit the grant.

Charles Mead made a motion to join 457 retirement program. Kenneth Mead seconded the motion.

Charles Mead made a motion to adopt Ordinance 7-2011 to change EIT ordinance collection Agency from Berkheimer to Centax and to restate it by Act 32 of 2008. Kenneth Mead seconded the motion.

Kenneth Mead a motion to adopt Ordinance 8-2011 requiring all persons, partnerships, business and corporations to abide by the following rules and regulations upon new construction and development within the Township. Charles Mead seconded the motion.

Charles Mead made a motion to advertise with a full page black and white ad in the County Association book. Kenneth Mead seconded the motion.

It was reported that the 2011 Clean Up Days were a success. The Township received \$1272. After review the Supervisors have decided to run the tire collection on Saturday only from 8 – 2 from now on.

Charles Mead made a motion to have the Township secretary attend the Understanding Oil and Gas Act and How it Impacts Municipal Regulations webinar for \$25. Kenneth Mead seconded the motion.

Charles Mead made a motion to meet payroll and bills as presented. Kenneth Mead seconded the motion.

Charles Mead made a motion to adjourn at 7:41. Kenneth Mead seconded the motion.
