The Supervisors discussed the Airport Zoning and any structures over 40 feet. Supervisors agree that property owner will have to file for permit not the gas company.

Kenneth Mead made a motion to repair Beebe Hollow Bridge parapet that the supervisors and Ken Rauch noticed cracks in. Charles Mead seconded the motion.

Supervisors are working with Williams Oil on access road to Hayes site to settle issues.

The Supervisors and secretary met with Justin Porter for Destiny Resources on another seismic testing project in the Township. At present the agreement is there will be no vibratory trucks on the Township Roads.

PenDot approved the watch children signs on Route 706.
